Cookie Management Policy

A cookie is a small packet of data stored by your browser, mobile, or any other device when you use our website and allow cookies. It helps our website recognize your device the next time you visit, provides access to certain features, and helps us understand the logic of how our website is used. Cookies allow us to distinguish you from our other visitors, providing a better user experience while also improving the functioning of our website.

Most browsers are set to accept cookies by default. You can probably configure your browser to receive alerts before accepting certain types of cookies or to reject specific types. However, if you disable the use of cookies in your browser, you may encounter difficulties in using some features of the website, and some may malfunction.

The following cookies may be used on the site:

Essential Cookies:

These are the most important or so-called 'essential' cookies, without which our website would not function properly. These cookies are used by default on the site. They do not store personal information.

Marketing Cookies:

These are not essential but are important for improving the user experience. This category includes sales cookies. We only use them with your consent. These cookies do not store personal information.

Analytical Cookies:

These are not essential but are important for improving the user experience. This category includes cookies used for statistical analysis (e.g., Google, Facebook). We only use them with your consent.
